

PURGE YOUR SPURGE!

MYRTLE SPURGE / NATIVE PLANT EXCHANGE

WHEN: Saturday, April 14 & April 21, 11:00 – 4:00 pm

WHERE: REI, 3285 East 3300 South

WHY

Myrtle spurge, also called donkey tail spurge, is a non-native, highly invasive plant that is rapidly spreading in our foothills and canyons. Help stop the spread by removing your spurge plants and substitute them with water-wise perennials.

HOW

- * Dig up and bag your myrtle spurge.
- * Remove at least 4" of the rooting clump.
- * Exchange your spurge for Utah grown native & water-wise plants.
- * Take home up to 5 plants per household.
- * Choose from: Sticky geranium, buckwheats, penstemons, desert four O'clock, blanketflower, and sundancer daisy.

** No limitations to the amount of myrtle spurge we will accept; bring as much as you can!*

**Plants available in 4" pots on a first come first serve basis.*
